

DO I NEED A WILL?

If you are an adult resident of Australia and have property in your name, you should ensure that you have a current (up to date), valid Will.

Your Will should:

- Name a person (or people) who will take charge of your affairs once you die - known as the executor (or executors)
- Clearly state who you wish to receive your assets - your beneficiaries
- Effectively deal with all of your assets. If you do not have a Will, or if you do not keep your will current, there is a risk that when you die, your assets will not pass to your intended beneficiaries.

We recommend that you consult a lawyer to ensure that your Will is valid and effectively deals with your estate.

WOULD YOU CONSIDER A BEQUEST TO YOUR SUB-BRANCH?

A Will is not about death. A Will shows you care about those you love. Making a Will can give peace of mind knowing that your wishes for family, friends and community organisations close to your heart have been made clear and will be honoured.

HOW DO I MAKE A BEQUEST TO THE BOX HILL RSL?

A bequest to Box Hill RSL could take one of many forms:

- The whole of your estate
- A proportion - "X per cent" - of your estate
- A specific gift - "the sum of \$?"

In certain cases, it may also be appropriate to leave items which you own to the Box Hill RSL (where they have special relevance to the Club). We suggest that you contact us before making gifts of this kind to ensure that they can be used by the Box Hill RSL.

The wording of the bequest is important to ensure that it can be used to the best possible advantage of all members of the organisation. Wherever possible, bequests to Box Hill RSL should be for "general purposes".

Whatever the form of gift, it should be left to:

You should consult a lawyer to help you draft your bequest. Every bequest, large or small, will make a difference to the welfare of all members.
